TIMES AND DATES: Check-in is Thursday, October 3, from 4:30 to 6:30pm at Fairlane Center NORTH LOBBY. A welcome program starts at 7:00pm and runs until 9:00pm. There is a 2nd check-in period from 8:00 to 9:00am Friday, October 4. Workshops run approximately 8:00am to 5:00pm Friday and Saturday.

PLACE: The conference will be held at the UM-D's Fairlane Center, North Building, at 19000 Hubbard Road, Dearborn, MI 48126. Parking is free in the North Lot at the far end of the Fairlane Buildings (North is 2nd building; you pass South on your way up the drive).
