The Region 2B, UAW Leadership, CAP Council Leadership and Advisory Council Meetings (Chaplaincy, Civil & Human Rights, Community Services, Education, IPS/Competitive Shops, Skilled Trades, Technical Office & Professional (TOP), Union Label, Veterans and Women's) will be held on Monday, April 22 through Wednesday, April 24, 2024, at the Marriott Indianapolis East, 7202 E. 21st St., Indianapolis, IN 46219.

The purpose and agenda for the Advisory Council meetings will be to discuss goals and missions, plan the Fall 2024 Advisory Council meetings and discuss any business of the Advisory Council.
