Only one (1) week session of July 21-26, 2024, is being offered, as indicated on the application, beginning on Sunday evening, and ending on Friday morning.

All active or laid off UAW members in good standing are eligible if they have never attended the program before. They must also be willing to use regular vacation, personal leave, or union leave time (where permitted by contract) to attend. **Past participants of Family Scholarship are not eligible to attend.**

Spouses and children/grandchildren 4-18 years old may attend. A birth certificate or proof of legal guardianship for each attending child may be required. Children under 4 years old cannot be accommodated, and other relatives, non-relatives, or retirees are <u>not</u> eligible to participate – <u>no exceptions!</u>

Please be aware only cars built by union members in North America may park on Education Center property. These are vehicles with VIN numbers starting with #1, #2, #4, or #5. All others must park outside the main gate and a bus will transport you to the Center registration desk.

Your Local may submit as many applications as you like. Allocation of space will be on a first come, first served basis, initially allocating one application per Local. Once our Regional allocation is filled, remaining applicants will be placed on a waiting list. If additional space becomes available for our Region, applicants on the waiting list will be contacted and offered the opportunity to attend the program.

Members should submit completed applications to their local union. Local union shall then ensure that applications are properly signed (President or Financial Secretary) and completed with the registration fee check in the amount of \$50.00, made payable to <u>UBE, Inc.</u> to the Region 2B office, Attn: Catie by Friday, June 21, 2024. <u>Applications received with no registration fee or proper signatures cannot be processed.</u>
