The 20th Annual Richard T. Gosser Scholarship Golf Classic Invitational will be held on Sunday, July 28, 2024, at Thunderbird Hills Golf Course in Huron, Ohio.

Initially the program awarded one \$2,000 scholarship. In 1982, we received a generous donation from the Richard T. Gosser Foundation which enabled us to increase the amount and number of awards. Richard T. Gosser was one of America's greatest Labor leaders who unselfishly dedicated his life to help those who work for a living to obtain a greater stature in life. He recognized the youth of today will have the responsibility of leadership in government and business in the future, he advocated that only through education and complete understanding of the problems confronting our great country can we hope to solve those problems and provide jobs for the coming generations as well as the present.

Throughout the years, we have been able to increase the number of scholarships and amounts. This year, twelve \$10,000 and seven \$1,500 scholarships were awarded to High School Seniors. We are proud to say, in all, \$3,360,500 in scholarships have been awarded benefiting 416 students of Region 2B, UAW members. To help maintain these outstanding scholarships, The Richard T. Gosser Scholarship Golf Classic Invitational was established. I have enclosed a registration form which explains in detail the sponsorship levels and the fun day of golf we have planned.
