





IN THE EVENT OF A STRIKE

The Local Union will assist you in getting a strike activity. Participation may be picket duty, community service, or other related assignments. You must be in good standing at the time of the strike to receive benefits.

- All members **must participate** in a strike activity **to be eligible** for strike assistance.
- Assignments will be posted at the Local, our Local website, and our official Facebook page.
- If you have not received your picket assignment, contact your Local Union.
- To qualify for your first strike assistant check, you must register on the day and time assigned to register.
- Members should bring smart phone or mobile device to registration.
- EACH MEMBER WILL NEED TO PROVIDE A PERSONAL EMAIL ADDRESS TO REGISTER.

- Picture Identification
- Home Address
- Social Security Number
- Date of Birth
- Dependent(s)'s Legal name, Birthday and Social Security Number(s)
- Bank Account Number (Note Savings or Checking Account)
- Routing Number
- Current Ford Medical Coverage Plan.
- *Note: If you or your dependents have another Group Health plan, please bring with you.

You must **sign in** when reporting for picket duty.

Strike Assistance is taxable. To avoid problems, keep a record of all strike assistance funds you receive.
